

TERMS AND CONDITIONS
CYBERSEC – BRUSSELS LEADERS' FORESIGHT 2020
24 March 2020, Brussels (hereinafter referred to as the "Terms")

§1. General terms

1. Definitions

- a. **"CYBERSEC BRUSSELS" CYBERSEC Brussels Leaders' Foresight 2020** - an international expert cybersecurity conference that will take place on 24 March 2020 ~~at the Microsoft Executive Briefing Center, Rue Montoyer 51, 1000 Bruxelles, Belgium~~ entirely online
- b. **"Organiser"** - the Kosciuszko Institute Association, with its registered seat in Krakow, Wilhelma Feldmana 4/9-10, 31-130 Krakow, TIN PL675-130-29-92, entered into the register of associations of the National Court Register maintained by the District Court for Krakow-Śródmieście, XI Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under Register No 0000145838, represented by Izabela Albrycht, Chairperson of the Board and Jarosław Kożuch, Vice-president of the Board
- c. **"Registration System"** - a web-based application owned by the Organiser to support the registration process of participants for the CYBERSEC BRUSSELS conference
- d. **"User"** - any person who uses the Registration System to register for CYBERSEC BRUSSELS
- e. **"Participant"** - a natural person aged 18+ who has full legal capacity, a legal person or an organisational unit without legal personality, but which may in its own name acquire rights and enter into obligations, who has successfully registered for CYBERSEC BRUSSELS via the Registration System and received a confirmation of participation in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS from the Organiser
- f. **"Entering into Agreement"** - the moment in which the participant receives confirmation of participation from the Organiser via e-mail. Henceforth, it is assumed that the User has entered into an agreement with the Organiser for the acquisition of the right to participate in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS, which will be confirmed by e-mail

2. Additional information

- a. The Registration System stores the User's registration details in a database and supports the registration process performed by the Organiser
- b. The Terms shall form an integral part of registration for participation in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS, and apply to all Participants.

§2. Online registration for participation in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS

1. The right to participate in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS is only acquired via online channels. You can register at cybersecbrussels2020.conrego.com.
2. Registration for conference participants lasts from 27th January to 23rd March until 23:59.
3. To successfully complete the registration process, the User must fill in all the fields marked with an asterisk (*).
4. The User confirms that all data entered in the registration form are correct; otherwise the User shall be declined to participate in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS.
5. After completing and confirming the veracity of the data provided in the registration form, an auto-generated message will be forwarded to the User's e-mail address provided in the form to confirm registration. ~~Due to a limited number of seats, the Organiser reserves the right to review applications and decline participation in the event. For organisational reasons, confirmation of participation will take place within 7 working days.~~
- ~~6. The number of people participating in the conference is limited.~~
7. Participation in the online registration process is tantamount to acceptance of these Terms.

§3. Terms of participation

1. The Organiser reserves the right to verify each Participant and their professional affiliation. During registration, you should use your business e-mail address.
2. If you register for participation in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS on behalf of another person, you confirm that you have written authorization of that person to make all necessary representations to comply with the requirements of these Terms.
3. After receiving an e-mail confirmation of successful verification, the party acquires the right to participate in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to decline participation without giving any reason for such a decision.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to change the CYBERSEC BRUSSELS agenda at any time, for any reason.
6. The Organiser shall not be made liable for any injuries sustained by the Participant nor any damages to their personal belongings that may be lost, destroyed or stolen during CYBERSEC BRUSSELS and the accompanying events.
7. The Participant covers the costs of travel, board and lodging, with the exception of a coffee break and lunch that are provided by the Organiser. Under particularly justified circumstances, travel and accommodation expenses of conference Speakers may be, at the discretion of the Organiser, paid by the Organiser in whole or in part.

8. The Organiser establishes the conference plan and reserves the right to modify it, even on the day of the conference, including the right to change the timetable and the order of presentations.
9. Changes to the conference agenda mentioned above shall not result in directing complaints towards the Organiser.
10. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the conference in the case of unforeseeable events that render the execution of the conference impossible.
11. The Participant shall comply with the requirements of these Terms and follow the health and safety rules, instructions, and organisational and technical directions made by the representatives of the Organiser.
12. Participants are financially liable for any damage they cause on the conference premises.

§4. Personal data

1. The Organiser is responsible for the administration of personal data provided by Participants. You can contact the Organiser by sending a message to the following e-mail address: rodo_at_ik.org.pl or by posting a letter to the address of the Organiser's office: Wilhelma Feldmana 4/9-10, 31-130 Krakow. The Organiser shall process personal data to the extent necessary to fulfil the needs of the conference and in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.
2. The detailed Information concerning the processing of the personal data of the Participants is provided during the on-line registration to the CYBERSEC BRUSSELS. This Information constitutes an Enclosure no. 1 to these Terms.

§5. Final provisions

1. Any disputes that may arise from participating in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS will be settled in a court of competent jurisdiction for the Organiser, in Krakow, Poland, in accordance with the Polish substantive and procedural laws.
2. Prior to CYBERSEC BRUSSELS, the Participant shall check in personally at the registration desk, at the entrance to the conference premises. For security reasons, Participants are required to present their identity card to a designated member of the Organiser's crew. If the Participant refuses to show their ID, the Organiser has the right to revoke their registration and deny entry on the premises.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to update and/or correct the Terms and conditions for participation in CYBERSEC BRUSSELS. The changes become effective upon the receipt of the updated terms and conditions by the Participant to the e-mail address provided by them during registration for CYBERSEC BRUSSELS.
4. In matters not covered by these Terms, the provisions of the Polish Civil Code apply.
